Monthly Consumer Price Index February 2020



Methodology of Somaliland Consumer Price Index (CPI)

This publication provides monthly Consumer Price Indices of Somaliland composite which is based on two main market baskets of Hargeisa urban households that was further sampled into 110 outlets. However, the current Consumer Price Index was constructed the results of the 2012 **Somaliland Household budget survey (SHS)**. During the exercise, markets were combined into the Index. Only the household final consumption expenditure data for the Hargeisa domain were analyzed and used to compute the Somaliland CPI weights. The CPI is now classified as an international standard, referring to: **Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP)**.

At the **elementary aggregate** (EA) level, the indices were computed using the Jevons (Geometric Mean) method for all items within the elementary aggregates. The modified Laspeyres index formula is used to compute **higher level indices**. The National CPI is computed as a weighted average of the two Markets, outlets mentioned above and indices are obtained from the **elementary aggregate** (EA) level.

Computation of the Monthly Inflation (M-o-M):

Monthly Inflation is calculated as the percentage change between the CPI of the current month and the CPI of the previous month.

Computation of the Annual Inflation (Y-o-Y):

Annual Inflation is calculated as the percentage change between CPI of the current month and the CPI of the same month but for the previous year.

Core:

Core contains goods and services, but does not include the food crop and energy. (This measure of inflation always excludes the above mentioned items which their prices are more volatile).

SOMALILAND CONSUMER PRICE INDEX

The Central Statistics Department of the Ministry of Planning & National Development (MoPND), has released the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Month of February 2020 (Base year 2012=100).

Highlights of CPI, February 2020.

1. Annual Inflation

The Annual Headline Inflation for the year ending of February 2020 was 5.0 percent compared to the 4.6 percent recorded for the year ended January 2020.

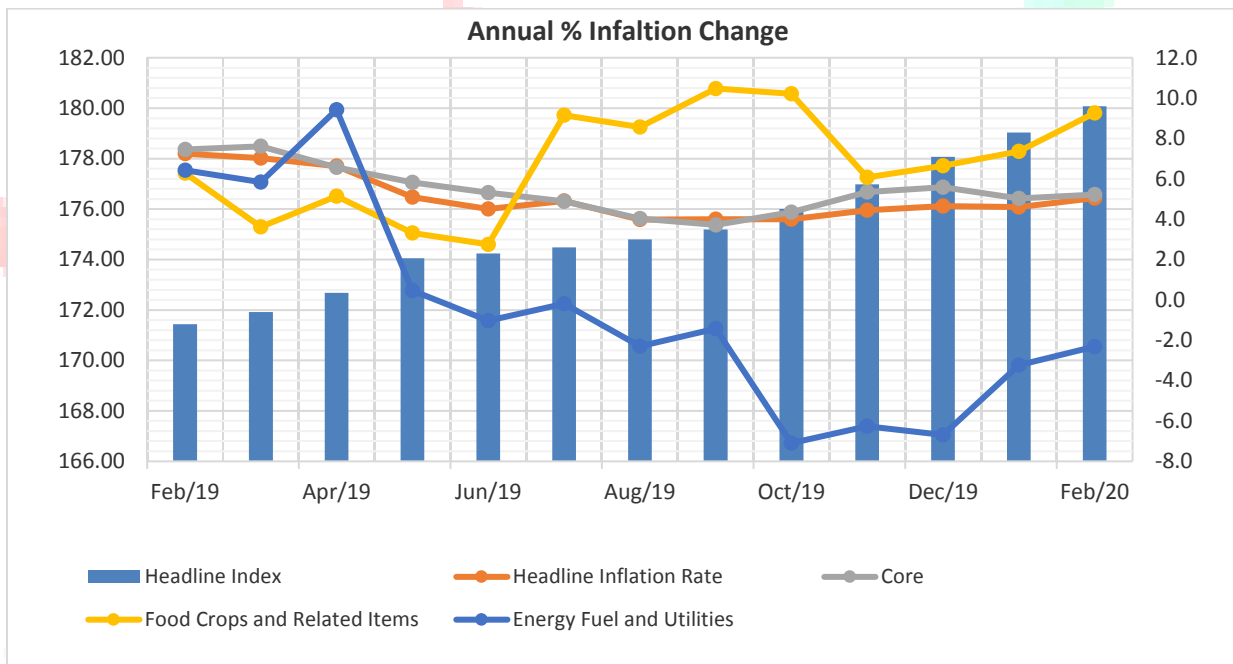
Annual Food Inflation of year ending February 2020 increased at 9.7 percent compared 9.4 percent recorded in year ended January 2020.

Annual inflation of Food Crops Increased at 9.3 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared to 7.4 percent recorded for the year ended January 2020. The change was attributed by **Guavas** which increased at 21.3 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared to 13.6 percent registered for the year ending January 2020. Meanwhile, the **Cabbages (Fresh or Chilled)** inflation registered 20.2 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared to the 18.2 percent recorded for the year ended January 2020. Similarly, **Melon** recorded at 43.7 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared to the 39.7 percent for the year ended January 2019. In addition, the **Garlic (Toon)** inflation increased at 12.0 percent for the ending year ending February 2020 compared to 8.9 percent for the year ended January 2020.

The Annual Energy Inflation, Fuels and Utilities (EFU) increased at (2.3) percent for the year ending February 2020 compared to (3.2) percent recorded for the year ended January 2020. The drivers were **Water Private Supplier's** inflation was increased at 6.9 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared to 4.1 percent recorded for the year ended January 2020. The **Charges - Use of Electricity** inflation increased at (10.2) percent for the year ending February 2020 compared to (10.7) percent recorded for the year ended January 2020.

The Annual Core inflation recorded at 5.2 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared to 5.0 percent for the year ended January 2020. This was driven by the **Sorghum, flour** inflation increased that 18.6 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared to 18.4 percent recorded for the ended January 2020. Similarly, **Live Goat/Sheep flour** inflation registered at 10.6 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared to the 6.9 percent recorded for the year ended January 2020. In addition, **Fresh fish** inflation increased at 13.6 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared to 21.0 percent recorded for the year ended January 2020.

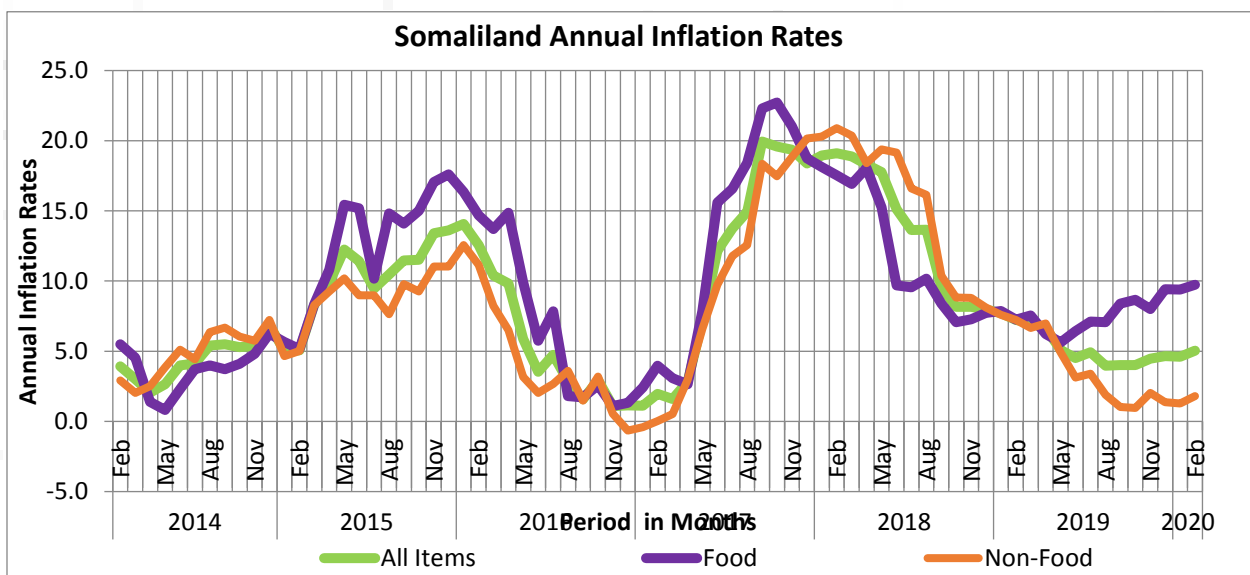
Graph 1: Somaliland Headline Index and Annual Inflation rates for 3 major components, February 2020– February 2020: (2012 = 100)

Also demonstrates that for the entire period from Jan 2014 to February 2020, it measured annual inflation, which has a negative impact on the households more especially those with a fixed income together with those with very low income and without any savings at all. The same graph shows that food prices were instable compared to non-food prices. Food prices changed more frequently and sharply mostly due the seasonal factors and exchange rate.



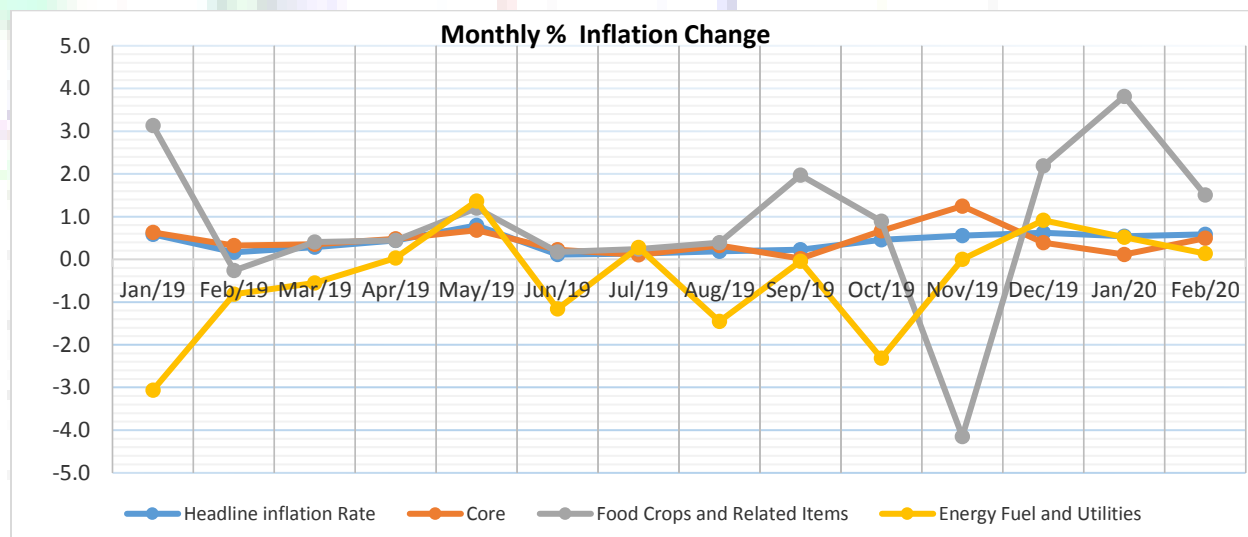
2. Monthly Inflation

The Monthly Headline Inflation for February 2020 increased at 0.6 percent compared to the 0.5 percent recorded January 2019.

Monthly **Food** Inflation of February 2020 decreased at 0.4 percent compared 0.9 percent recorded in January 2020.

Food Crop & Related items monthly Inflation decreased at 1.5 percent in February 2020 compared to 3.8 percent recorded in January 2020, In addition **Core** monthly inflation increased at 0.5 percent during February 2020 compared to 0.1 percent recorded in January 2020. Similarly, the Monthly **Energy Fuel & utilities** Inflation decreased at 0.1 percent for the month of February 2020 compared to 0.5 percent recorded during January 2020.

01. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Annual Inflation for **Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages** an increased to 9.1 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared 8.8 percent recorded for the year ended January 2020.

02. Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics

The Annual Inflation for **Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics** an increased to 10.1 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared 6.2 percent recorded for the year ended January 2020.

06. Health

The Annual Inflation for **Health** an increased to 7.3 percent for the year ending February 2020 6.4 percent recorded for the year ended January 2020.

11. Restaurants and Hotels

The Annual Inflation for **Restaurants and Hotels** an increased to 0.7 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared 0.4 percent recorded for the year ended January 2020.

12. Miscellaneous Goods and Services

The Annual Inflation for **Miscellaneous Goods and Services** an increased to 4.3 percent for the year ending February 2020 compared 1.2 percent recorded for the year ended January 2020.

The Monthly Inflation for **Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics** an increased by 5.3 percent for February 2020 compared (1.7) percent recorded January 2020.

10. Education

The Monthly Inflation for Furnishings, **Education** a increased by 0.3 percent for February 2020 (0.7) percent recorded January 2020.

11. Miscellaneous Goods and Services

The Monthly Inflation for **Miscellaneous Goods and Services** by increased to 3.4 percent for February 2020 compared to 1.5 percent recorded January 2020.
