## Monthly Consumer Price Index May 2020



## FOREWORD

This publication provides monthly Consumer Price Indices of Somaliland composite which is based on two main market baskets of Hargeisa urban households that was further sampled into 110 outlets. However, the current Consumer Price Index was constructed using weights derived from the results of the 2012 **Somaliland Household budget survey (SHS)**. During the exercise, markets were combined into the Index. Only the household final consumption expenditure data for the Hargeisa domain were analyzed and used to compute the Somaliland CPI weights. The ***Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP)*** is used.

The ***elementary aggregate*** (EA) level, indices were computed using the Jevons (Geometric Mean) method for all items. The modified Laspeyres index used to compute ***higher level indices***. The national CPI computed as weighted average of Hargeisa markets.

## Acronyms and Definitions

**COICOP:** Classification of Individuals Consumption According to Purpose - is a nomenclature developed by the United Nations Statistics Division to classify and analyses individual consumption expenditures incurred by households, non-profit institutions serving households and general government according to their purpose.

**CPI:** Consumer Price Index – a general indicator of price levels paid by households for consumer goods and services.

**CPI basket:** A commonly used term for the goods and services priced for the purpose of compiling the CPI.

**Elementary aggregate (EA):** The lowest level of commodity classification in the CPI, and the only level for which index numbers are constructed by direct reference to price data.

**Inflation:** A term commonly used to refer to changes in price levels. A rise in prices is called inflation, and a persistent fall is called deflation.


**Jevons price index:** An elementary price index defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the sample price relatives. It can also be defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the sample price relatives. It can be defined as the un-weighted geometric average of the current to base period price relatives.

**Laspeyres price index:** the laspeyres price index is an index formula used in price statistics for measuring the price development of the basket of goods and services consumed in the base period. The question it answers is how much a basket that consumers bought in the base period would cost in the current period.

**Outlet:** The interface between a supplier of products and the consumer. It may be a shop, a market stall, a catalogue etc. also referred to as a “retail outlet”, although it can include wholesale outlets which also sell directly to the consumers.

**Outlier:** The term used to describe any extreme value in a set of data, such as a price or price relative that requires further investigation or has been verified as incorrect price relative: a measure of price movements: the ratio of the price level in one period to the price level in another.

**Reference base:** The period in which the CPI is given a value of 100.0. The CPI is currently on a reference base of 2012.



**Weight:** The measure of the importance of an item in the index regimen relative to the other items. Weights can be expressed in either quantity of value terms. Value weights are used in the CPI.

**Computation of the Monthly Inflation (M-o-M):**

Monthly Inflation is calculated as the percentage change between the CPI of the current month and the CPI of the previous month.

**Computation of the Annual Inflation (Y-o-Y):**

Annual Inflation is calculated as the percentage change between CPI of the current month and the CPI of the same month but for the previous year.

**Core:**

Core contains goods and services, but does not include the food crop and energy. (This measure of inflation always excludes the above mentioned items which their prices are more volatile).

## 1.0 HIGH LIGHTS OF CPI FOR APRIL 2020

*The Central Statistics Department of the Ministry of Planning & National Development (MoPND), has released the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Month of May 2020 (Base year 2012=100).*

### 1.1 ANNUAL INFLATION

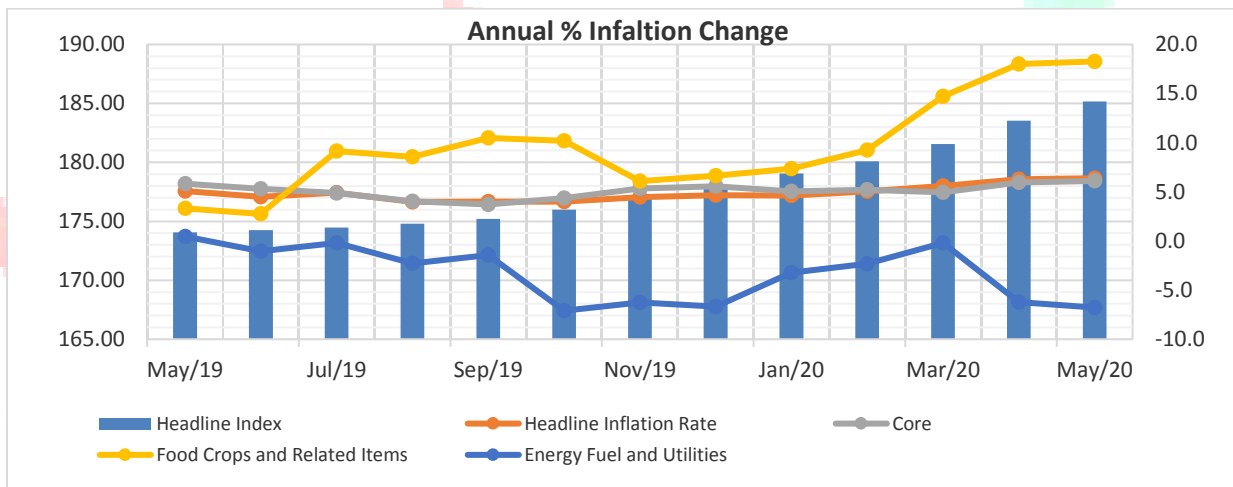
The **Annual Headline Inflation** for the year ending May 2020 remains 6.3 percent compared to the 6.3 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020.

**Annual Core Inflation** increased by 6.1 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared to 6.0 percent for the year ended April 2020. This was driven by different items like **Cakes** inflation, which increased at 16.4 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared to 12.4 percent, recorded for the ended year April 2020. Similarly, **Maize, flour** inflation increased at 25.4 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared to 18.5 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020. In particular, **Cattle meat** inflation increased by 10.8 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared to 5.5 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020. Also, **Other Spices** inflation increased by 29.9 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared to 27.7 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020.

Annual inflation of **Food Crops and related items** increased at 18.3 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared to 18.0 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020. The drivers of changes were **Tangerines** which increased at 41.1 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared to 39.8 percent registered for the year ending April 2020. Meanwhile, the **Guavas** inflation registered an increase of 26.7 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared to the 23.5 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020. Similarly, **Cabbages (Fresh Or Chilled)** increased at 19.7 percent for the ending year May 2020 compared to the 15.6 percent for the year ended April 2020. In addition, the **Green Pepper** inflation increased at 27.4 percent for the ending year May 2020 compared to 25.2 percent for the year ended April 2020.

The **Annual Energy Fuel and Utilities** inflation decreased by (8.1) percent for the year ending May 2020 compared to (6.2) percent recorded for the year ended April 2020. The drivers were **Charges - Use of Electricity** inflation which decreased by (28.6) percent for the year ending May 2020 compared to (24.2) percent recorded for the year ended April 2020. The drivers were **petrol** inflation decreased by (25.6) percent for the year ending May compared to (23.6) percent recorded for the year ended April 2020. In addition, **Kerosene** inflation increased by (17.2) percent for the year ending May compared to (10.6) percent recorded for the year ended April 2020.

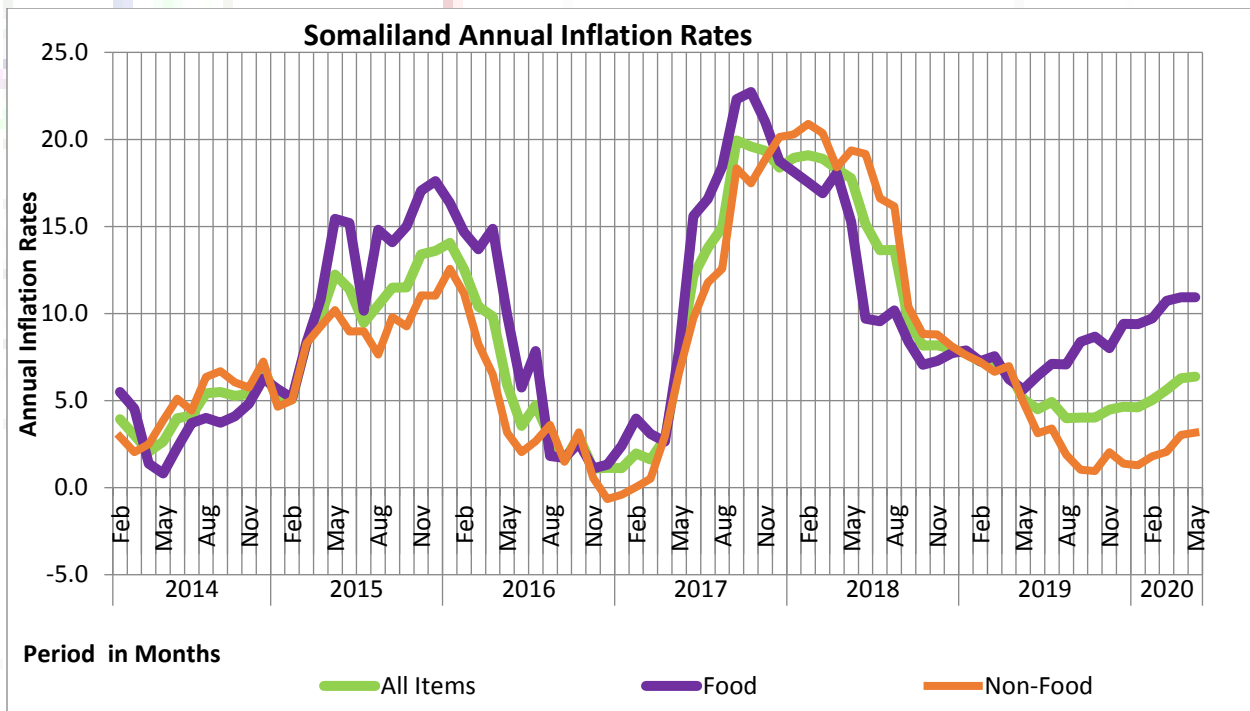
**Graph 1.1: Somaliland Headline Index and Annual Inflation rates for 3 major components, May 2019–May 2020: (2012 = 100)**

Also demonstrates that for the entire period from Jan 2014 to May 2020, it measured annual inflation, which has a Positive impact on the households more especially those with a fixed income together with those with very low income and without any savings at all. The same graph shows that food prices were instable compared to non-food prices. Food prices changed more frequently and sharply mostly due the seasonal factors and exchange rate.

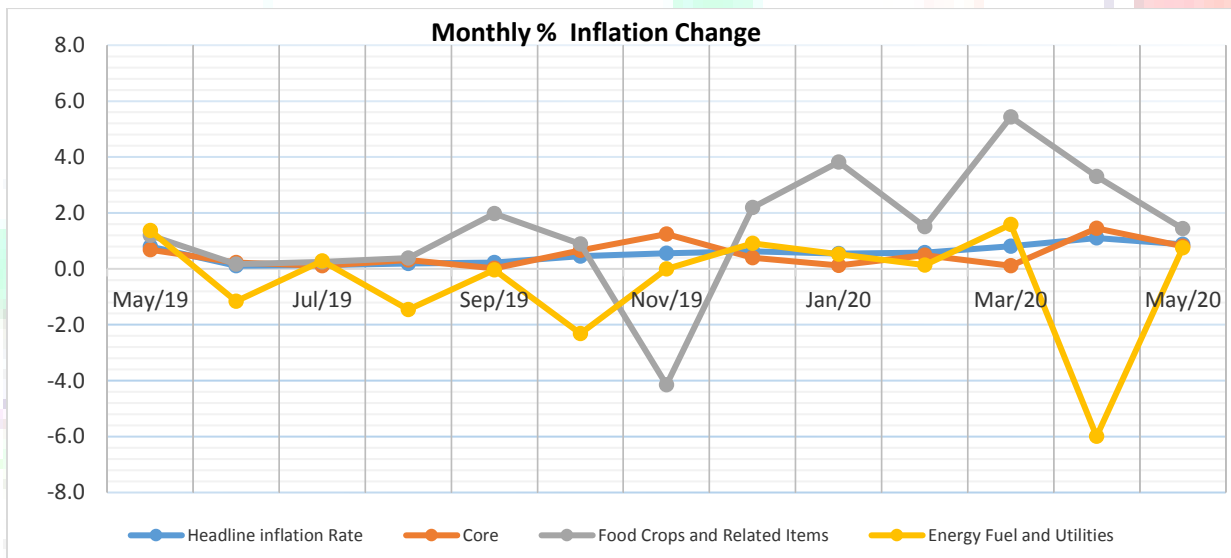
## 2.0 MONTHLY INFLATION

The **monthly headline inflation** for May 2020 decreased by 0.8 percent compared to the 1.1 percent recorded April 2020.

Monthly Food inflation of May 2020 increased by 1.3 percent compared to 1.2 percent recorded in April 2020

**Food crops** and related items monthly inflation decreased by 1.4 percent in May 2020 compared to 3.3 percent recorded in April 2020. In addition **Core** monthly inflation decreased by 0.8 percent during May 2020 compared to 1.4 percent recorded in April 2020. Similarly, the monthly **Energy Fuel and Utilities** inflation decreased at (0.7) percent for the month of May 2020 compared to (6.2) percent recorded during April 2020.

### 3.0 ANNUAL INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS

#### 01. Food and Non-alcoholic beverages.

The annual inflation for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decrease to 9.1 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared 10.4 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020.

#### 03. Clothing and Footwear

The Annual Inflation for Clothing and Footwear increased to 4.7 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared 4.4 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020.

#### 05. Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

The Annual inflation for Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance remain to 5.3 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared to 5.3 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020.

#### 06. Health

The annual Health inflation increase to 13.4 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared 11.1 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020.

#### 07. Transport

The annual Inflation for Transport remain to 9.3 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared 9.3 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020.

#### 09. Recreation and Culture

The Annual inflation for Recreation and Furniture increased 5.1 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared 4.5 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020.

#### 12. Miscellaneous Goods and Services

The Annual inflation for Miscellaneous Goods and Services increased 8.8 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared 8.3 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020.

### 3.1 MONTHLY INFLATION BY COICOP DIVISIONS

#### 01. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The monthly inflation of **Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages** increased by 0.0 percent for May 2020 compared 1.1 percent of April 2020.

#### 02. Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics

The monthly inflation of **Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics** increased by 0.4 percent for May 2020 compared to (2.4) percent recorded April 2020.

#### 07. Transport

The monthly inflation of Transport decreased by 0.3 percent May 2020 compared to 8.7 percent of April 2020.

#### 09. Recreation and Culture

The monthly inflation of Recreation and Culture decreased 0.3 percent May 2020 compared to 1.5 percent of April 2020.

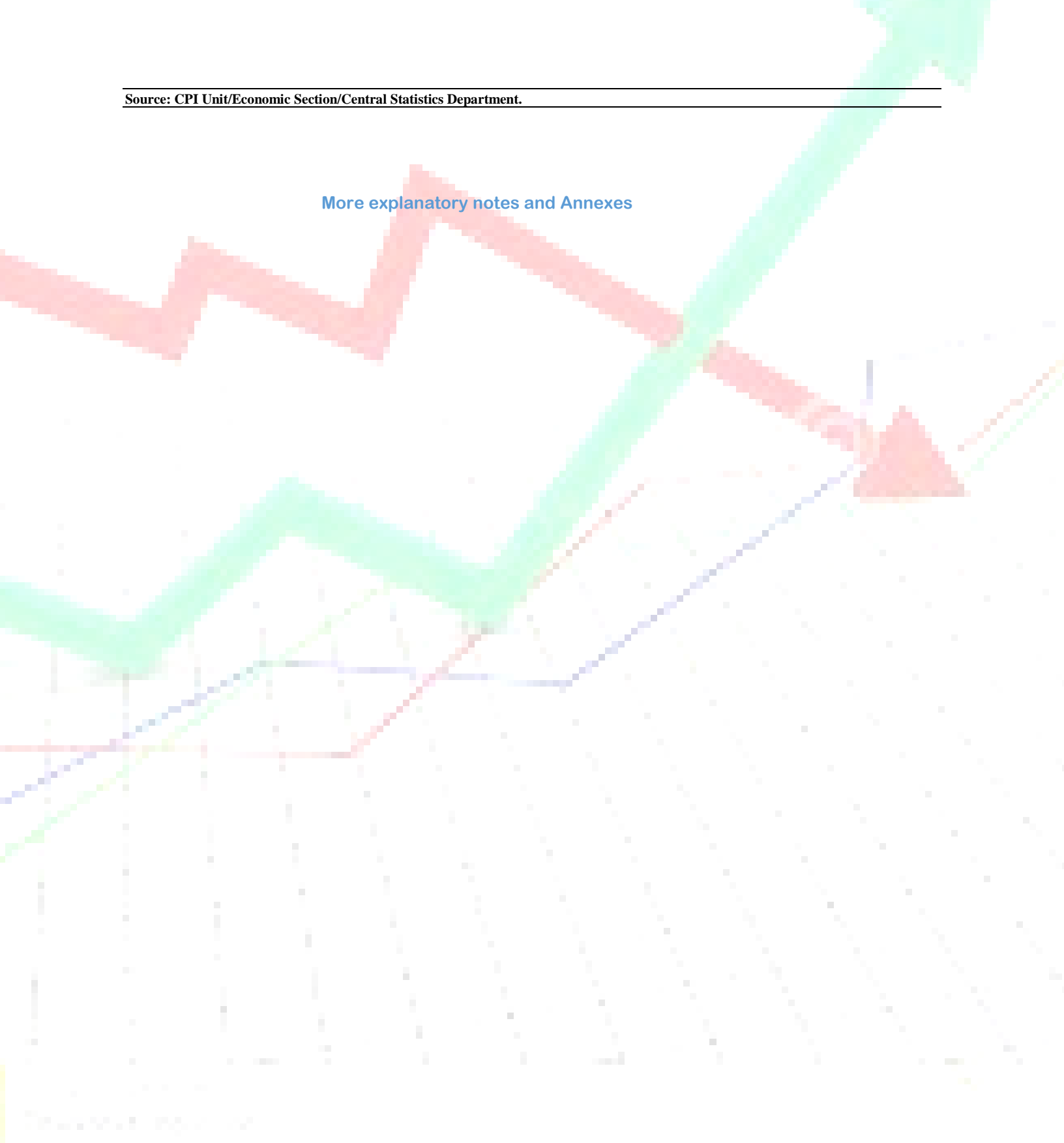
#### 11. Restaurants and Hotels:

The Annual Inflation for Restaurants and Hotels decreased to 1.2 percent for the year ending May 2020 compared 1.3 percent recorded for the year ended April 2020.


