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Monthly Consumer Price Index April-2019



<u>Methodology</u>

This publication provides monthly Consumer Price Indices of Somaliland composite which is based on two main market baskets of Hargeisa urban households and Hargeisa was further sampled into 124 outlets. However, the current Consumer Price Index was constructed the results of the 2012 Somaliland Household budget survey (SHS). During the exercise, markets were incorporated into the Index. Only the household final consumption expenditure data for the Hargeisa domain were analyzed and used to compute the Somaliland CPI weights. The CPI is now classified as an international standard, referring to: Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP).

At the *elementary aggregate* (EA) level, the indices were computed using the Jevons (Geometric Mean) method for all items within the elementary aggregates. The modified Laspeyres index formula is used to compute *higher level indices*. The National CPI is computed as a weighted average of the two Markets, outlets mentioned above and indices are obtained from the *elementary aggregate* (EA) level.

Computation of the Monthly Inflation (M-o-M):

Monthly Inflation is calculated as the percentage change between the CPI of the current month and the CPI of the previous month.

Computation of the Annual Inflation (Y-o-Y):

Annual Inflation is calculated as the percentage change between CPI of the current month and the CPI of the same month but for the previous year.

Core:

Core contains goods and services, but does not include the food crop and energy. (This measure of inflation always excludes the above mentioned items which their prices are more volatile).

SOMALILAND CONSUMER PRICE INDEX

The Central Statistics Department of the Ministry of Planning & National Development (MoPND), has released the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Month of April 2019 (Base year 2012=100). Highlights of CPI, April 2019.

1. Annual Inflation


The Annual Headline Inflation for the year ending April 2019 decline at 6.6 percent compared to the 7.0 percent recorded April 2018.

The Annual Food Crops Inflation increase 5.1 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to 3.6 percent in April 2018. The drivers of changes were **Beans**, dry increase to 7.3 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to 2.4 percent registered similar month previous year. **Cabbages (Fresh Or Chilled)** inflation registered an increase 19.5 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to the 14.4 percent recorded to the corresponded similar month previous year. Similarly, **Sweet/ripe bananas** inflation increase 12.1 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to 10.4 percent to corresponding month of the previous year. In addition, the **Mango, Avocado pea** inflation increase 13.9 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to 25.8 percent corresponded similar month of the previous year.

The Annual Energy Inflation, Fuels and Utilities (EFU) increase to 9.4 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared 5.8 percent recorded to corresponding month of the previous year. The drivers were **Diesel** inflation increase 9.6 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to (3.8) percent recorded to the corresponding month of the preceding year. In addition, the **Petrol** Inflation decrease (5.1) percent in April 2019 compared (7.4) percent recorded in corresponding similar month of the previous year.


The Annual Core inflation decrease to 6.6 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to the 7.6 percent to corresponding month April 2018. This was driven by the **Wheat, flour** inflation decrease to 8.7 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to 16.7 percent recorded during the corresponding month of the previous year. **Cattle meat** inflation decrease to 7.5 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to the corresponding month of the last year. Similarly, **Tomato ketchup** inflation decrease to 12.6 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to 5.9 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to the corresponding month. Finally, the **Cloth soap** inflation increase to 5.9 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to the 14.1 percent recorded to the corresponding similar month.


Graph 1: Somaliland Headline Index and Annual Inflation rates for 3 major components, April 2018 – April 2019: (2012 = 100)



2. Monthly Inflation

The Monthly Headline Inflation for April 2019 increase 0.4 percent compared to 0.3 percent recorded in March 2019. The Core monthly inflation increases 0.5 percent during April 2019 compared to the 0.4 percent recorded in March 2019. In addition Food Crop & Related items monthly Inflation remains constant by 0.4 percent in April 2019 to 0.4 percent recorded in March 2019. Similarly, the Monthly Energy Fuel & utilities Inflation Increase by minus 0.6 percent for the month of April 2019 compared to 0.03 percent recorded during March 2019.





Graph 3: Somaliland Annual Inflation Rates

Graph 3 also demonstrates that for the entire period from April 2014 to April 2019, it measured annual inflation, which has a positive impact on the households more especially those with a fixed income together with those with very low income and without any savings at all. The same graph shows that food prices were instable compared to non-food prices. Food prices changed more frequently and sharply mostly due the seasonal factors and exchange rate.

EXPLANATORY NOTES FOR THE INFLATION OF APRIL 2019

1. Most Contribution of Annual Inflation (COICOP)¹ by Divisions (Group)

The driving of Annual Inflation according to COICOP is described in the following paragraphs.

01. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages

The Annual Inflation for Alcoholic Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decrease by 6.4 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to 7.4 percent recorded for the Corresponding similar month of the previous year.

03. Clothes & Footwear

The Annual Inflation for **Clothes & Footwear** decrease by 9.9 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to 13.7 percent recorded for the Corresponding similar month of the previous year.

05. Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

The Annual Inflation for Housing, water, electricity, Gas & other fuels decrease to 8.5 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to 11.6 percent recorded for the Corresponding similar month of the previous year.

06. Health

The Annual Inflation for **Health** decrease to 1.8 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to 4.8 percent recorded for the Corresponding similar month of the previous year

11. Restaurants and Hotels

The Annual Inflation for **Transport** decrease to 5.4 percent for the year ending April 2019 compared to 6.6 percent registered for the Corresponding similar month of the previous year.

COICOP is Classification of Individual Consumption according to Purpose, which is the United Nations recommended classification of products for the CPI, National Accounts and Household Budget Surveys.
