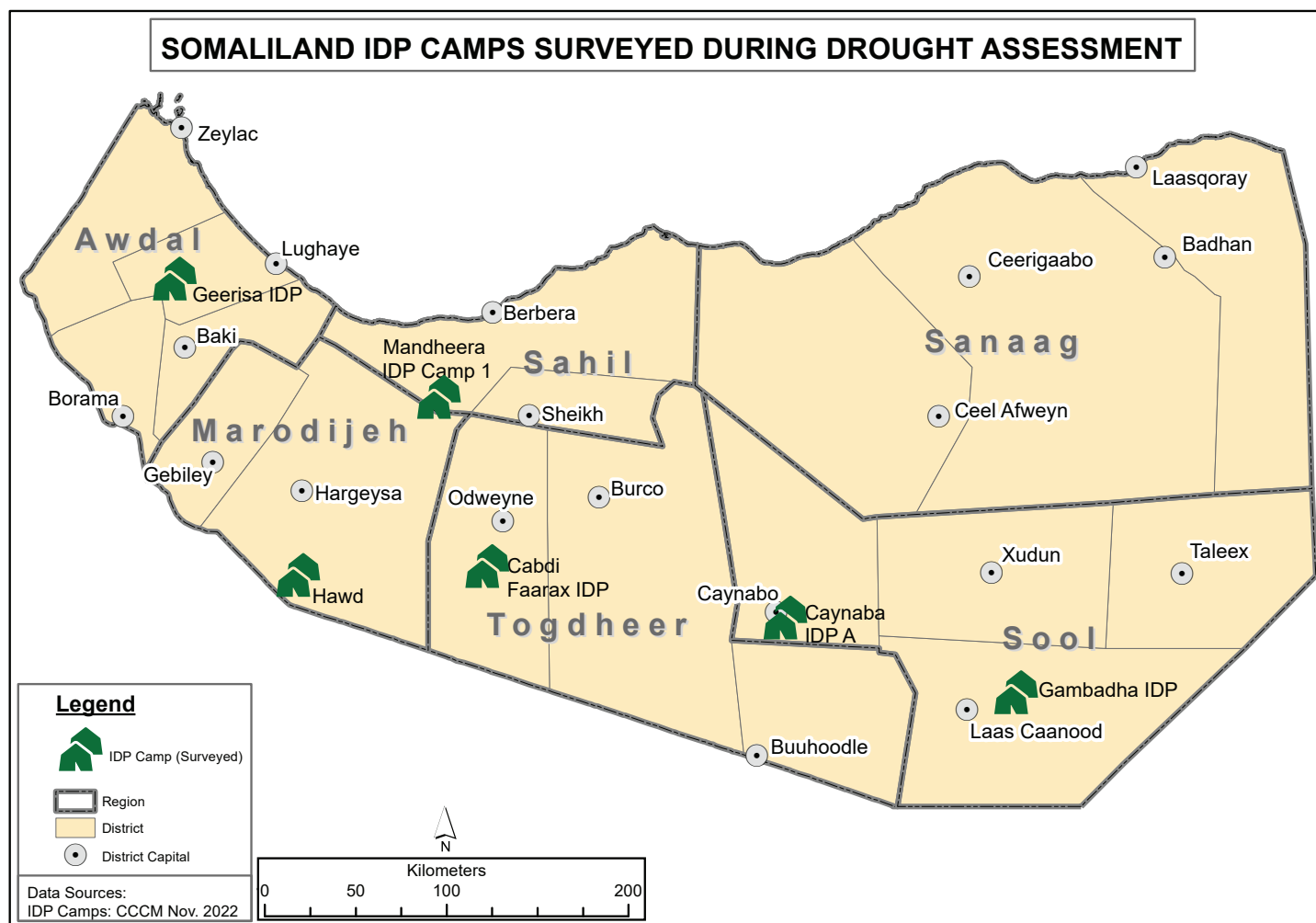


Assessment of drought affected population in IDP camps 2022 - Preliminary findings

IDP displacement characteristics



a) Reason for moving to the camp	
Lost of livestock	35.1%
Drought (lack of water)	34.9%
Drought (lack of pasture)	26.8%
Conflict	2.1%
Other	1.2%



b) When the IDPs left place of origin	
This year (2022)	10.7%
One year ago, 2021	6.4%
Two years ago, 2020	7.2%
More than two years	41.5%
Camp is their place of origin	34.3%



c) Time taken from the place of origin	
One Day	42.7%
2 Days	28.4%
3 Days	11.2%
4 Days	5.0%
5 Days	4.3%
Over 5 days	8.3%
