

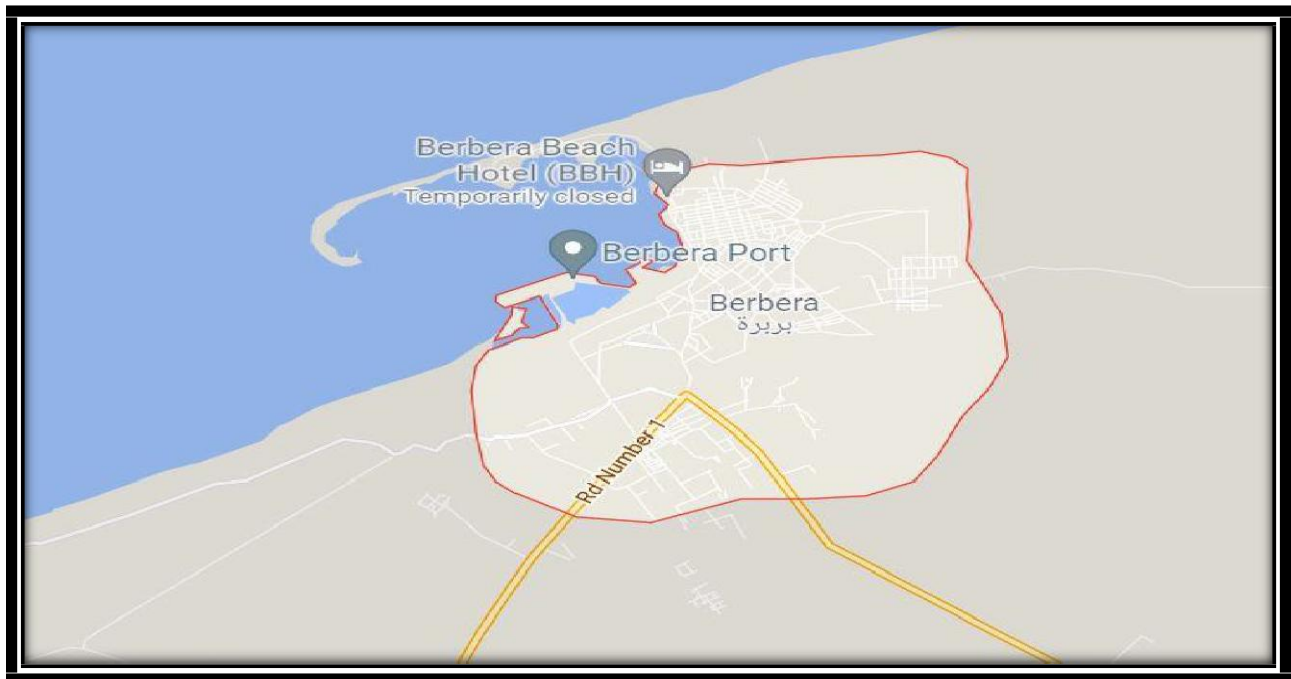
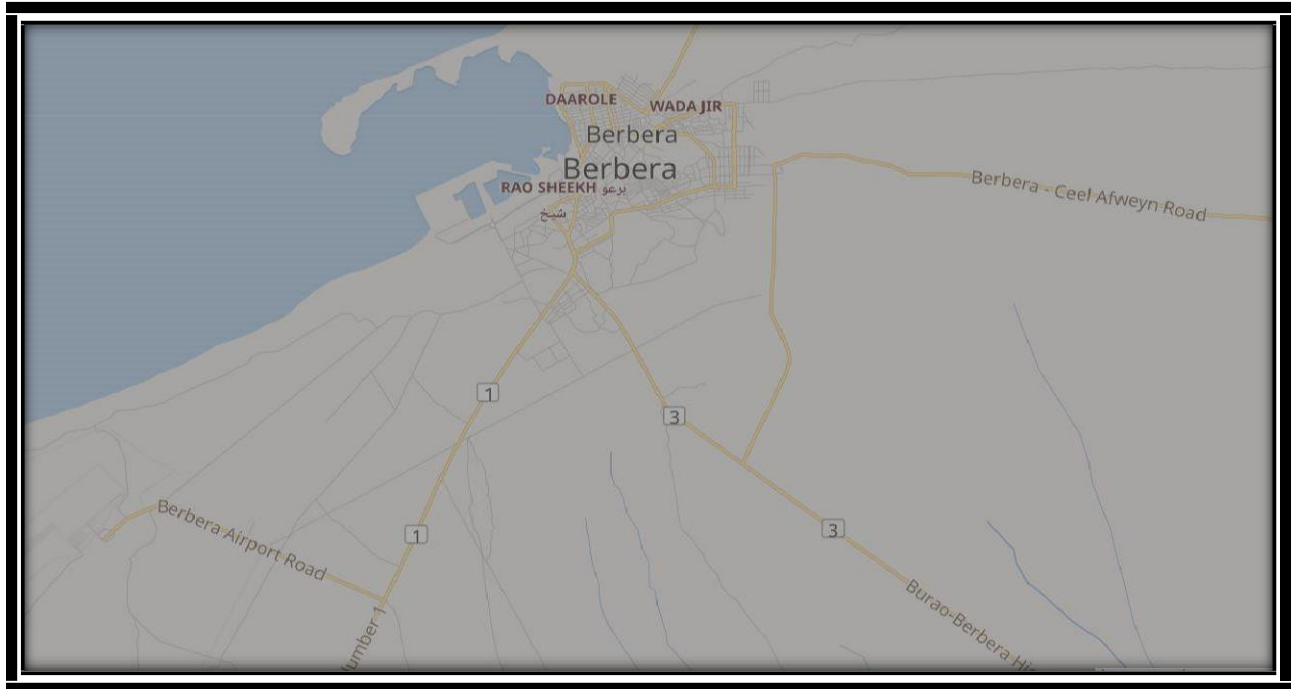

Map of Berbera

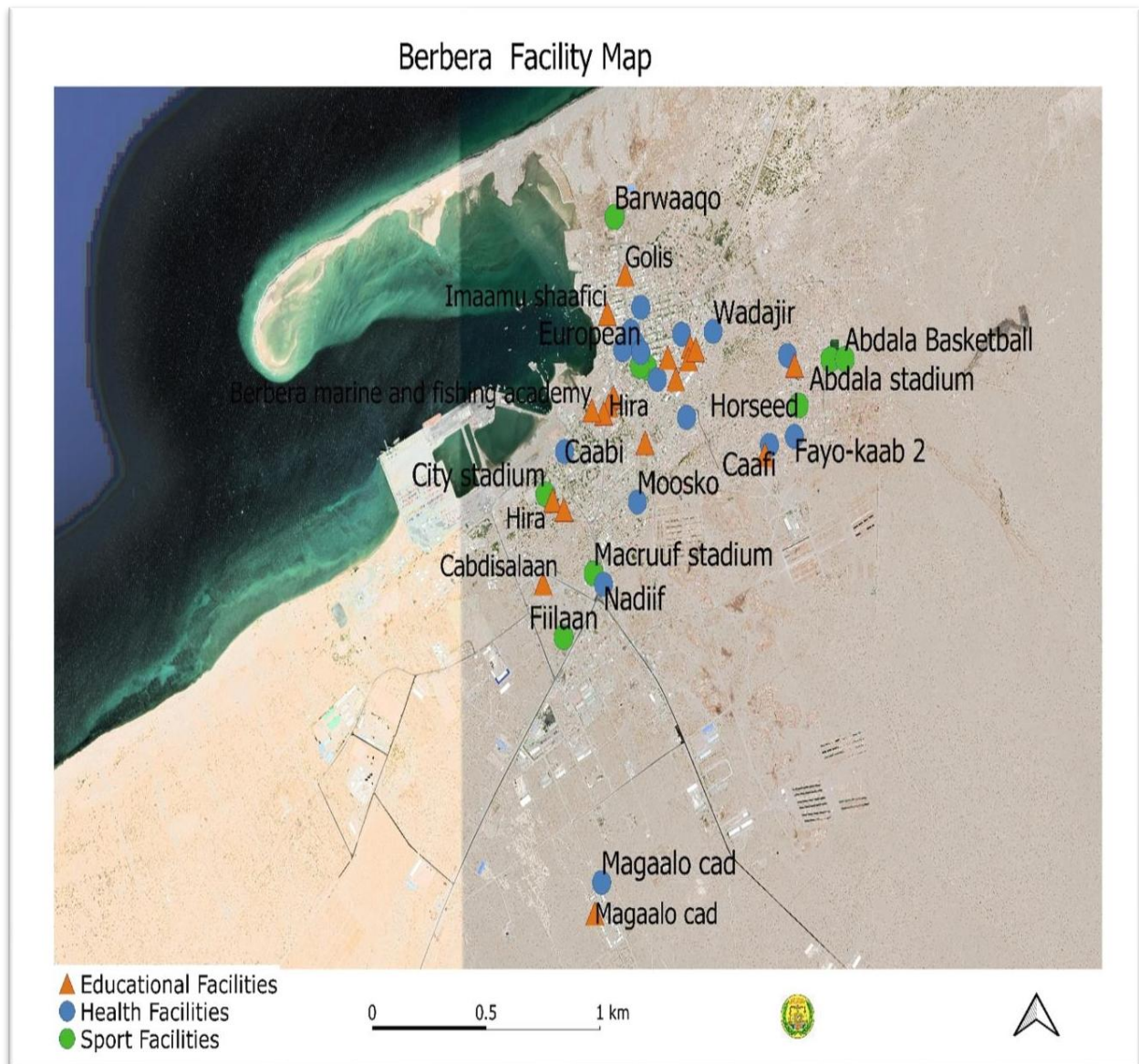

Berbera Facility Maps



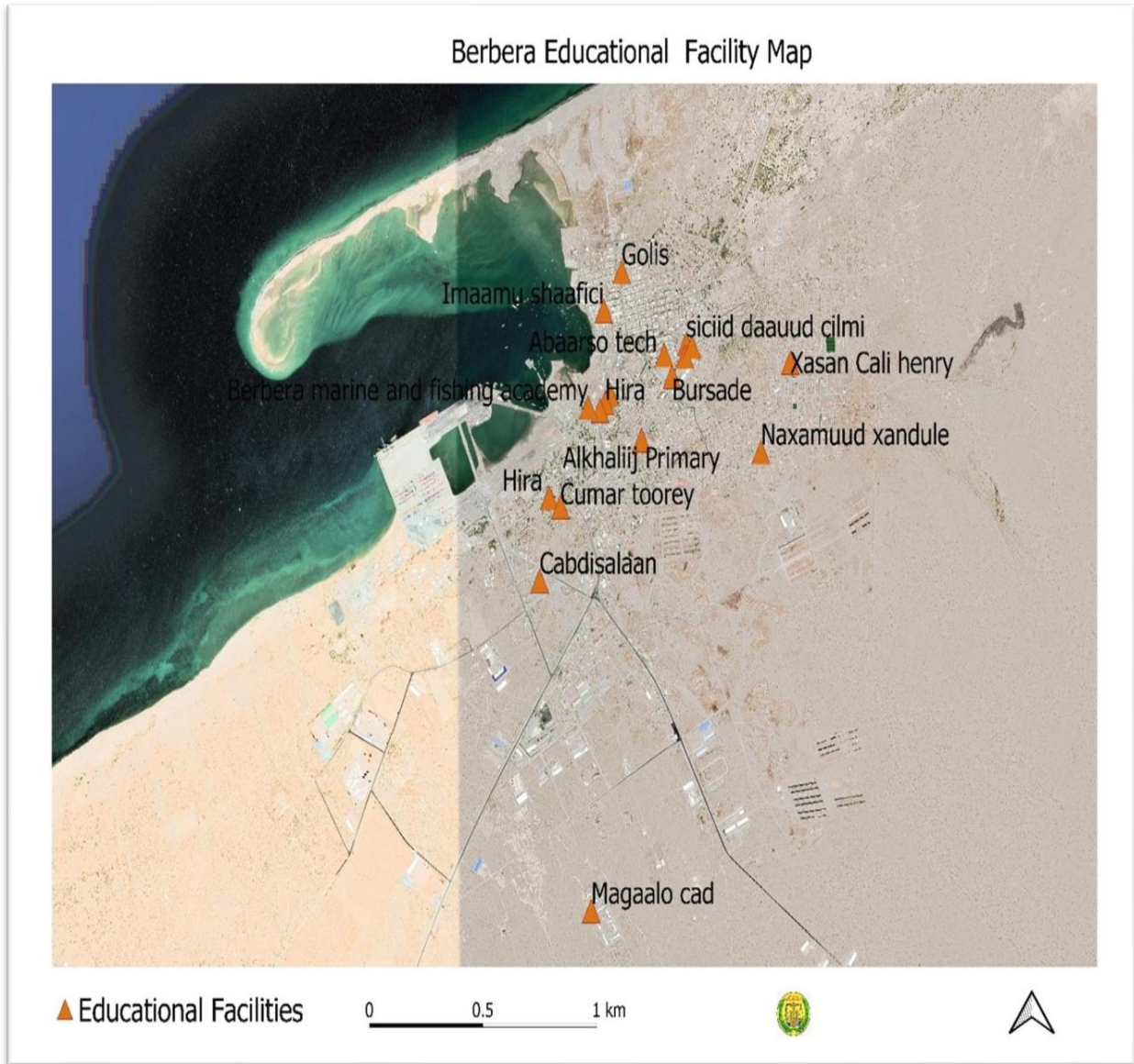

Introduction

Berbera is the capital of the Sahil region of Somaliland and is the main sea port of the country. Berbera is a coastal city and was the former capital of the British Somaliland protectorate before Hargeisa. Berbera features a hot arid climate. It has long, sweltering summers and short, hot winters, as well as very little rainfall. Average high temperatures consistently exceed 40 °C or 104 °F during nearly four months of summertime (June, July, August and September) (Deutscher 2016).

The Berbera Municipal administration is led by a mayor and local city councils who are to be elected by every five years. Berbera Local municipality plays a very important role in the communities under the district locality. The local government have its own structure of admiration to serve the community. It was established to provide fundamental facilities and services to the community within the boundary of the district. The local government make sure that the facilities planned can reach effectively for those people living under this district.

Improvements in quality and scope of the data produced by Municipalities is a necessity in order for the Somaliland Government to have sufficient basis for making informed policy decision and monitoring the implementation of plans and guidelines, most notably the National Development Plan (NDP).

Beyond their role in NDP monitoring, functional local Municipalities are also vital to the implementation of the NDP through their planning functions, as their mandate also includes the translation of the national and sector priorities and objectives into institutional strategic and operational plans. These further enables collection and compilation of city level administrative records, services and facilities on a regular basis in order to promote their service provisions.

Against this backdrop, the Berbera Municipality with the support of Ministry of National Planning and Development (MNPD) and UNFPA produced Berbera Municipality Statistical Abstract booklet. The booklet contains information mainly from survey and administrative records from different institutions, local government and agencies in the district.

The Municipality Statistical Abstract provides a reliable source of information that contains different set of indicators and facility provision that are important for planning, executing and evaluation in order to support for better decision making as well clear path way of the future direction of district. This abstract also provides the level of different services and facilities and their progress development with regarding for the last three years. It is useful to be refereed as an important way of knowing the gaps in the district and which can be improve based on the target and the annual plans set by local government.
