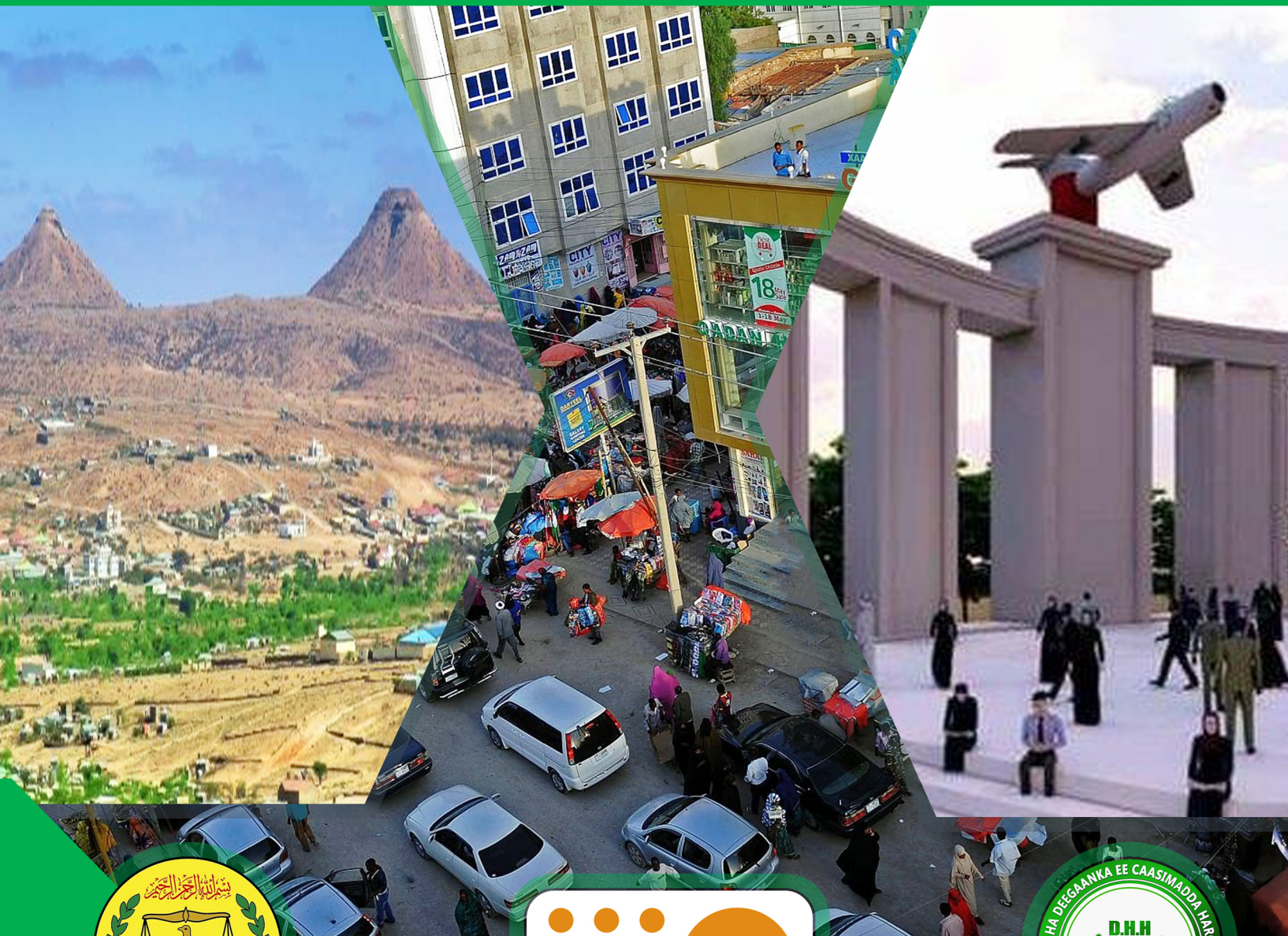

INTRODUCTION

Hargeisa is the capital and largest city of Somaliland. It is situated in the Marodijeh region and is the seat of the parliament, the presidential palace and government ministries. Hargeisa is located in a mountainous area and sits at an elevation of 1,334 meters (4,377 feet) above sea level (Deutscher, 2016). Despite its location in the tropics, Hargeisa seldom experiences either very hot or very cold temperatures due to the high altitude. The average monthly temperatures in Hargeisa range from 18 °C or 64.4 °F in the months of December and January to 24 °C or 75.2 °F in the month of June. The highest and lowest recorded temperatures are 35° (95.0 F) and 2.8° (37.0 F) respectively. The city receives the bulk of its rain between the months of April and September, averaging just over 400 millimeters (16 in) of rainfall annually (Wikipedia).

The population of Hargeisa is estimated to be 1.2 million (David, 2019), however, based on rural-urban migration and the city growth in general, officials believe that the current population is actually now more than 1.5 million people. The urban area occupies 75 square kilometers (29 sq mi), with a population density of 12,600 inhabitants per square kilometers (33,000/sq mi) (World Factbook, 2013). The city is serviced by an underground water source, Geb-Deble, which lies 40km outside of Hargeisa. However, there are frequent outages due to the limited storage capacities and other institutional constraints. There is a main public power station, but most of the households use private means of connection. A major challenge for the city is waste collection, which is usually just disposed on vacant land (Tempra, Jacobs, Demissie 2007).

The Hargeisa municipal administration is led Mayor and local city councils who are assumed to be elected every five years.

Improvements in quality and scope of the data produced by municipalities is a necessity in order for the Somaliland Government to have sufficient basis for making informed policy decision and monitoring the implementation of plans and guidelines, most notably the National Development Plan (NDP).

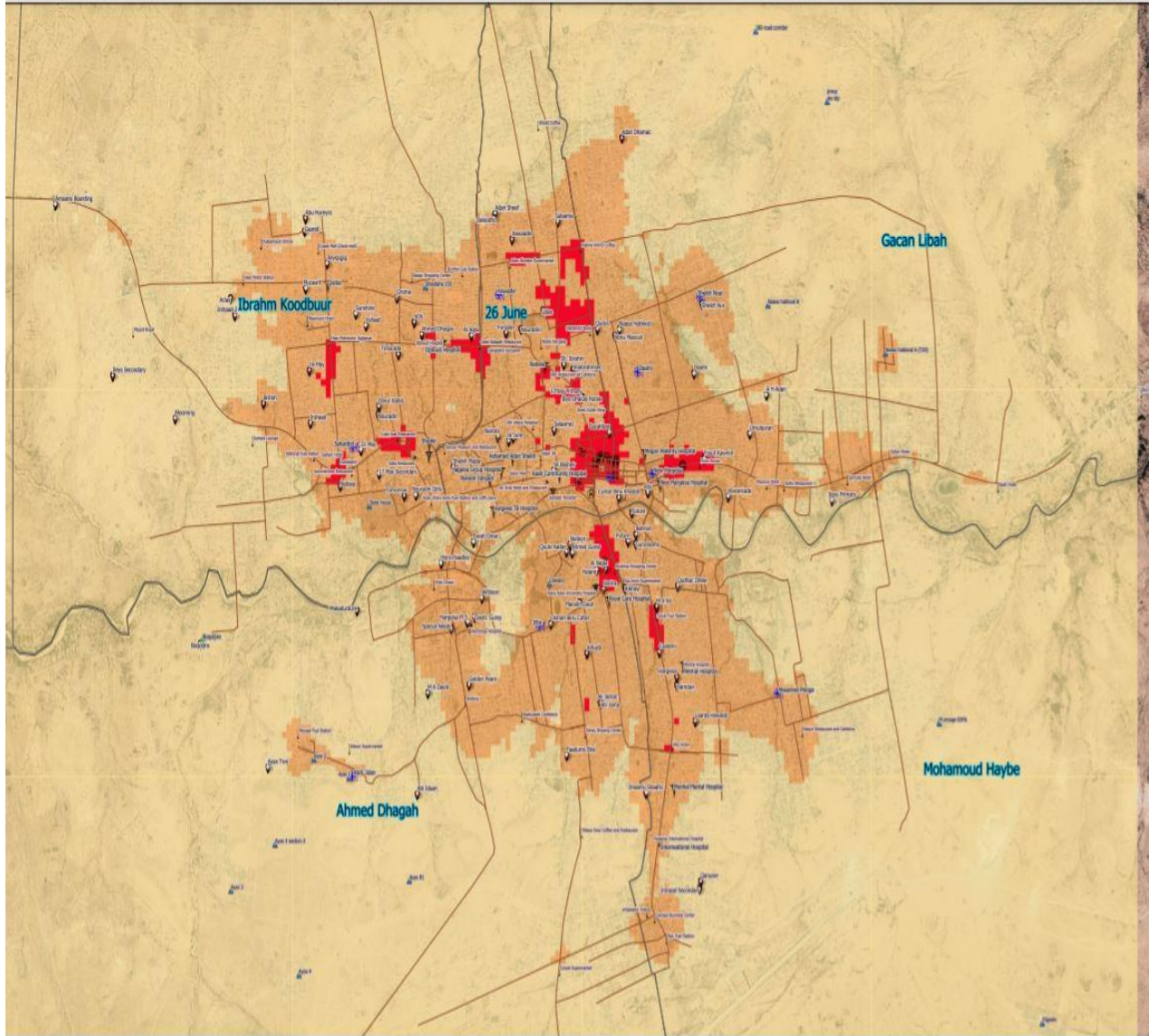
Beyond their role in NDP monitoring, functional local municipalities are also vital to the implementation of the NDP through their planning functions, as their mandate also includes the translation of the national and sector priorities and objectives into institutional strategic and operational plans. These further enables collection and compilation of city level administrative records, services and facilities on a regular basis in order to promote their service provisions.

Against this backdrop, the Hargeisa Municipality with the support of Ministry of National Planning and Development (MNPD) and UNFPA produced Hargeisa Municipality Statistical Abstract booklet. The booklet contains administrative records from Hargeisa Municipality and other public and private institutions in Hargeisa city.

The information collected and compiled in the booklet will be a valuable input to the detailed design and implementation of the development projects. Notably, the information assists to

precisely delineate the areas in which Hargeisa Municipality requires to give priority and the most efficient way for a concerted effort to provide it with the capacity it needs.
